



The Automated Import Reference System (AIRS) shows the import requirements for Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) regulated commodities.

Access the <u>Automated Import Reference System (AIRS) (opens in new window)</u> and follow the series of drop down options that include:

- the Harmonized System (HS) classification
- origin
- destination
- end use and miscellaneous qualifiers pertaining to the commodity for import

What to consider when using AIRS (Automated Import Reference System):

- importers should consult Acts as passed by Parliament to interpret and apply the law
- AIRS (Automated Import Reference System) is only for reference
- AIRS (Automated Import Reference System) information is updated frequently
- importers are responsible to ensure their information is accurate at the time of importation
